How was Wuhan Recovering from the most Severe Area of COVID-19

Chinese Spring Festival of 2020 is bound to be unusual and memorable due to the outbreak of COVID-19.

On 8th Dec, 2019, the first patient of Novel Corona virus Pneumonia was detected in Wuhan, and it was diagnosed and named NCP on 12nd Dec 2019.

Government also postponed the resumption of work, postponed students' school time to prevent any crowed virus infection.

2. Build two new hospital--Vulcan Mountain hospital and Raytheon Mountain Hospital to accommodate more patients.

Competing with the "Epidemic Evil", from January 25th, Wuhan "Vulcan Mountain" Hospital was completed and come into use within ten days. The hospital is 33,900 square meters overall and was capable of accommodating 700-1000 sickbeds.

At the meantime, the other hospital -- Raytheon Mountain was also implemented on January 25 and put into service on February 8. The total area was 79,700 square meters, with a total of 1,600 sickbeds.

The facts have proved that these two hospitals played a great role during the epidemic, they also proved that only Chinese could create such unbelievable huge project.

3. Collect Medical Teams from All Over Country to support Wuhan

All provinces across the country assigned medical teams to assist Wuhan, summing up to 340 medical teams and 42,000 medical staffs to the battlefield. Among these medical heroes, some were the young 90s, some were the elder after retirement. They were fighting together with Wuhan, they saved lots of people's life, and they were all the most fearless heroes in this battle.

4. Collect Medical supplies and life necessities to support Wuhan

Besides the support of medical teams, all province as well as some charitable organization, entrepreneurs, they also donated a lot of medical supplies like mask, face guard, protective clothing and other life necessities to support Hubei.

At that period, people all over China and even the whole world were all standing together with Wuhan, praying and blessings for Wuhan. WUHAN FIGHTING!

Thanks to the day and night dedication from medical staff's, thanks to our compatriots who fighting against the NCP battle in the front line, thanks to any tiny help from the public, on the 76th days after the "lockdown of the city", Wuhan, which was most affected by the Novel Corona virus Pneumonia epidemic, finally woke up with the bell ring of the Jianghanguan building.
